PROLIFIC PROPAGATION

Plantlets grow on leaf edges and root when they fall off



CARE REQUIREMENTS

- **Light:** Bright, indirect sunlight. Partial shade in hot climates.
- **Watering:** Drought-tolerant. Water every 14-21 days; let soil dry out between waterings.
- **Soil:** Well-draining, cactus or succulent mix.
- **Temperature:** Warm conditions. Tolerates down to 40°F (4°C).

FERTILIZATION

Fertilize once a year with succulent/cactus fertilizer at half strength



BLOOMING AND LIFECYCLE

Tall flower spikes with coral-pink blooms. Typically blooms once, then dies, but plantlets ensure continuation

TOXICITY

Toxic to pets and children if ingested. Causes vomiting, diarrhea



PROPAGATION METHODS

- **Plantlets:** Remove and plant them. Easiest method
- **Cuttings:** Can be used but less common

GROWTH HABIT

Rapid growth. Often grown in pots to control spread
